« On December 30<sup>th</sup> 1847, Jean Létourneau, from St-Joseph in Beauce and husband of Rosalie Bisson buys lot no 54 » (1) on the Kennebec Road « he settles there with his 7 children in the first months of 1848 ». Lot 54 belonged to Exilia Trépanier a few years ago. On December 23<sup>rd</sup> 1852, he buys lot no 35, 1<sup>st</sup> range, East of Aubin de l'Isle where he moves. Since then, the house built on this lot no 35 has been the property of his descendants, today: Jean Létourneau(2) the fifth of the name in St-Côme, son of Jean-Thomas and Jeanne d'Arc Paquet, grandson of Joseph and Marie Loignon, greatgrandson of Jean the 2<sup>nd</sup> and Pétronille Morissette and great-great-grandson of Jean and Rosalie Bisson, the first arrived in St-Côme.

The nine first children were born in St-Joseph-de-la-Nouvelle-Beauce. This surname was given to all the descendants of Jean-Paul Létourneau, son of Paul, grandson of Guillaume, the Létourneau ancestor in Nouvelle-France. Brother Éloi-Gérard writes **Paulette** in his book Recueil de généalogies.
